Catholic Identity

- Promoting collaborative and inclusive practices that supports Individual learning needs.
- Providing a School wide SELS and Student Experience program.

Pastoral Wellbeing

Doxa School will promote a safe environment for all members of our community that promotes kindness and curiosity.
